

## PAINT ....a library bag for school



Make your kids Library bag for School, or even better let them do it themselves.

It's easy, it's fun and they will be proud of their work.

They can make them personal and fun. Also a great Christmas Present for the little ones!

1. Draw a design onto the library bag or trace a picture.
2. A stencil can also be used.
3. Childrens' colouring books, magazines, serviettes – all come in handy for ideas to put on your library bag.
4. Slip cardboard or plastic between the 2 layers of the library bag.
5. Paint the design onto the fabric, using Dala 100% water-based fabric paint -safe for children – no strong odour
6. Colour the extra detail first, such as leaves, before painting the main motif.
7. You can now paint the background – if you so wish – not essential.

Outline your picture to give it a professional finish. For outlining we use a Dala fabric paint liner in applicator bottle with nozzle – a variety of colours available.

Leave to dry.

Heat set the library bag with an iron on the reverse side.

The textile paint has now been permanently fixed onto the fabric and your library bag is fully washable.
